Preparing Prostate Specimens for Transport

I. Complete requisition form, only one patient per requisition form.

 Label each vial with the appropriate information. Use blue or black ink only.

3. Place each specimen into the corresponding vial. Secure cap tightly and place each vial into the appropriate section of the specimen tray. Multiple core specimens from the same area should be placed in the same collection vial. Be sure to discard any unused formalin collection vials to avoid confusion.

4. Enslose the Test Requisition and secure Prostate Kit for transport.
